36. General update

The clerk update member on the following:

- Other works as highlighted re the play area and cemetery are underway

- A leaflet is being produced for the new X16 bus service to Morpeth and Newcastle and delivery to all houses in Stannington Village and Netherton Park will be arranged as well as posters in all notice boards
- The annual parish tea is planned for 27 October (2-4pm) and all residents and user groups are invited as well as children and parents of the school and Freemen. Invitations will be sent out.

- Bridge at Tranwell is now reopen for vehicular traffic however there have been a number of accidents in the interim
- Residents have reported that a new road is being constructed to the old boiler house at the Whitehouse Centre and other unauthorised works – report to Northumberland County Council
- A damages lamp post at one of the mini roundabouts in the village has been reported by Cllr Scott
- Concern was expressed at grass cutting on the A1 causing traffic to file off onto rural road networks
